2 次の英文を読み、下の問い(問1～4)に答えよ。

A: Hey, Bob, did you read the article about a “fat tax” in yesterday’s paper? There is a proposal to put a tax on all unhealthy foods, including things like soda, processed foods and fast food.

B: I heard about that. But, I think it’s a bad idea in so many ways.

A: Really? Why is that?

B: I think people should make their own choices about what they eat, and the government shouldn’t interfere with people’s dietary decisions. Eating fatty foods doesn’t harm other people so let people decide what they want to eat. Also, I feel this tax would hurt the poorest people in our country. They are sometimes forced to buy cheaper and often healthier foods because they don’t have much money. A tax would hurt these people the most in my opinion.

A: I understand what you are saying, but I have to disagree. Don’t you think obesity is a major problem in our country? There has been a sharp increase in diabetes, coronary disease, strokes, and cancer. Many of America’s biggest health problems are connected with diet. The tax could help raise money to pay for healthcare for those who really need it, like the poor and obese Americans. I also believe that people will start to buy healthier foods if the taxes make unhealthy foods too expensive for an average family’s income.

B: You have a point, John, but the bottom line is that education is the answer, not governmental pressure. Do you think we are doing a good job of educating our children so that they can make healthier choices?

A: It could be better. Nutritional education does need to be reformed. People need to learn to make better nutritional choices. Let’s hope this happens in the future. I really would like to see some kind of change, either through health education or new taxes. Once we get through this morning traffic jam and park the car at the office, let’s continue our talk. This debate is just getting interesting!
